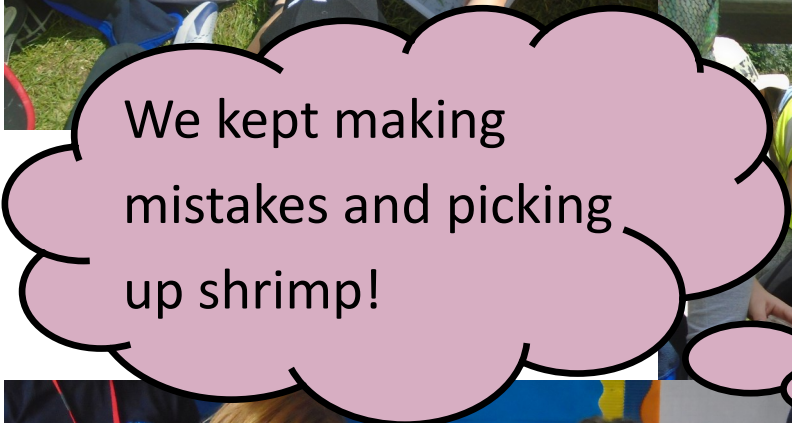


Mayflies—River's Trust



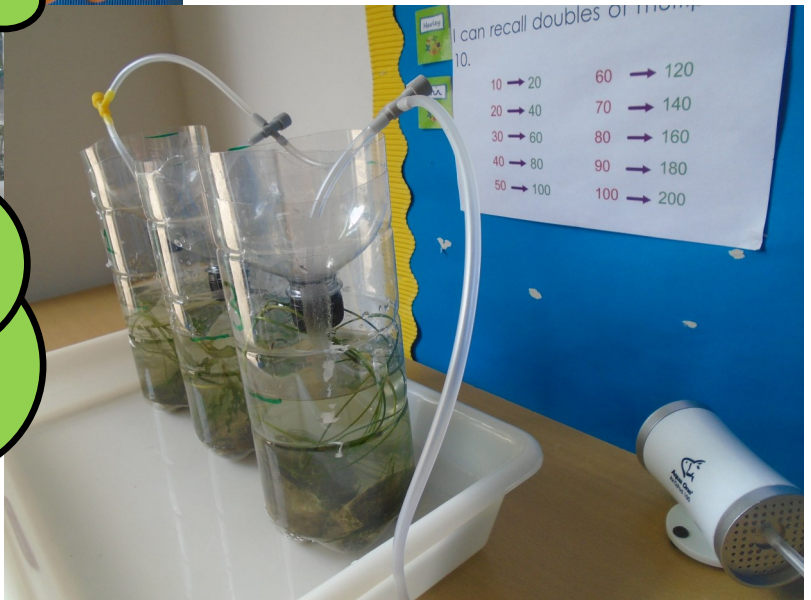
My group has a water skidder.

It was so spicy!



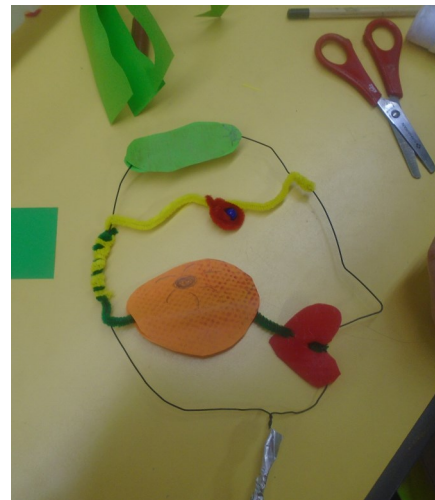
We then went to the Art Gallery. We saw the Guiseppe Archimboldo painting and had a go at sketching it.

I loved it but it was revolting!

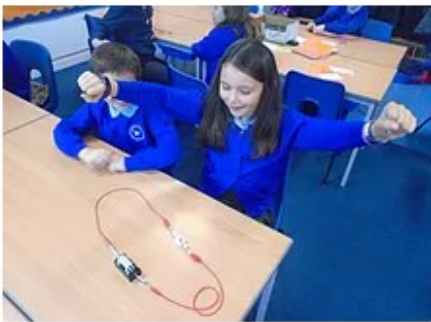
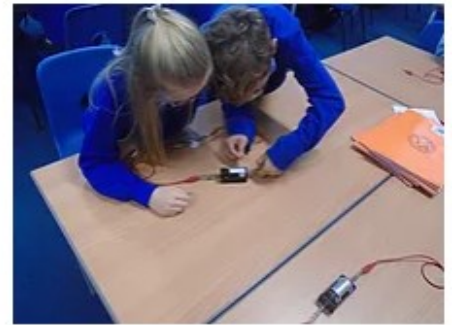
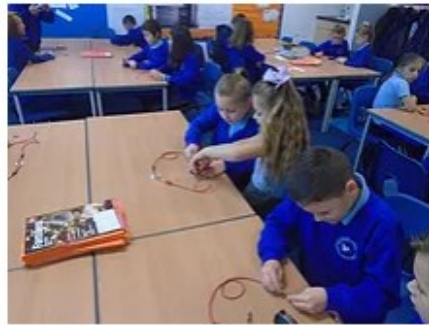


Some of us didn't enjoy it but it was great watching everyone have fun and we learned loads.
